Dell Command Updates

Once the updates are finished, a quick restart is required to lock those improvements in—thanks for helping us keep our tech secure!

Turning off Devices VS Restarting Device

Did you know that certain system updates can only install during a restart? Simply closing your laptop or hitting 'shutdown' won't do the trick.
